HOW TO PREPARE FOR A TIME OF DISASTER

While it is not possible to predict what disasters might befall our district, the primary threats are bushfires and storm/cyclone events. There are many things locals can do to lessen the impacts of such events. Here is a short checklist to start you thinking.

- * Are your insurance policies up to date?
- * Do you have a family evacuation plan?
- * What will you take if you evacuate and where will you go?
- *Do you keep all vegetation around your property trimmed to lessen potential storm damage or fire risk?
- * Can you access water during an emergency?
- * Have you access to a battery powered radio with fresh batteries?
- * Can you find ABC Coast FM 90.3 on your radio?
